- प्रथम पत्र को लिखित परीक्षा समूह/उपसमूहका लागि संयुक्त रूपमा एउटै प्रश्नपत्रबाट एकैदिन वा छुट्टाछुट्टै प्रश्नपत्रबाट छुट्टाछुट्टै दिन पनि हुन सक्नेछ । यसैगरी द्वितीय पत्रको परीक्षा पनि समूह/उपसमूह अनुसार अलग अलग दिन छुट्टाछुट्टै प्रश्नपत्रबाट हुनेछ ।
